
#### Lead by example.....

Harley Earl's visionary concept cars for General Motors culminated with the Cadillac Cyclone XP-74 With it's bubble -top canopy,



sweeping fenderes afterburner-style headlights, and fins, Earl's concept car reflects the ongoing facination with the jet age. The Cyclone XP-74 featured proximity-sensing radar safety units (housed in the "Dagmar" front fender extenisons) that scanned the road and warned the driver of obstructions. The Cyclone's bubble top retracted fully when the doors opened or cloed, and it had an intercom system that allowed passengersto speak to those outside the car. Earl retired during the Cyclone's produc-tion and some features were changed, including the fins and the canopy, by the new head of GM design, Bill Mitchell. The influence of the four fins in back is evident in the production '61 and '62 Cadillacs. Though initiated a an experimental design suiotable for a Motorama, the Cyclone never appeared in one. Instead it debuted at the 1959 Daytona 500.




