





Arnie "The Farmer" Beswick a drag racing legend and icon will be featured with his "Tameless Tiger" Pontiac. Arnie will be available both days for photo

ops and autographs along with a host of other drag racing notables from the past and present. Al Joniec famous for his "Batman" race cars will be presenting an engine seminar on Saturday from 10 a.m. until noon. Friday is Dave Strickler Day a Salute to another legend whose famous "Old Reliable" Chevrolets became household names. The Ford Fairlane Club will have their awesome Ford display in the fairgrounds on Friday all day. The Annual

Legion of Honor Awards will be presented to nine deserving recipients at 5 p.m. Each recipient receives an individual award and their name is placed upon a perpetual award on display in the museum in perpetuity.

Saturday is Ed Miller & George Cureton Day with a Salute to the 50th Anniversary of their NHRA World Championships at Tulsa, Oklahoma. Special race car displays will accompany both World Champs on a day to remember. It happens one time!

The new addition at the museum will feature the Frantic Ford funny car and the Grumpy's Toy IV Camaro of Bill Jenkins along with a host of vendors with drag racing memorabilia from the past.

"Ohio George" Montgomery will be on hand to compliment the new Willys gasser display in the museum.

A flea market features vendors with a host of interesting automotive items both days in the fairgrounds.

Saturday also features a Glory Days Cruise-in and Car Show from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Awards will be presented including a giant Best of Show award.

A sensory experience is presented both days with legendary race cars starting-up and providing the



familiar music to a drag racers' ears.

Admission is \$10.00 per day or a special two-day ticket for \$15.00. The event financially supports the Eastern Museum of Motor Racing.

Activities continue on Sunday with the 14th Annual York Nostalgia Nationals at Beaver Springs Dragway, Beaver Springs, Pennsylvania. See many of the legendary race cars competing in this special event that occurs but one time each year.

3. Where can I find a copy?

Most of the advertisers whom list their address and have a retail location open to the public have a copy for you-don't forget to buy something you need from them- after all, they are the one's paying for your free magazine.

4. Where is it distributed?

Central Maryland, Northern Delaware, and South East Pennsylvania. Our current rate structure that is based on printing 6000 copies doesn't allow us any further expansion. From the start, with the constant demand for more and more magazines, we doubled the amount of copies we print. Now we have almost 15,000 print readers, and get almost 100,000 visits to the website each year. All without increasing advertising rates in seven years!

5. Can you just mail me a bundle of magazines for my club? I have been doing just that for years, spending hundreds of dollars to get magazines to the outlying areas. Some clubs have stepped up to help with the freight, and I appreciate that. If your club or group wants copies and are not in my normal delivery area, contact me.

6. How come my show is not in the magazine?

Did you email or mail me a copy of your free listing? We do collect flyers at some events, but to ensure your show is in the magazine-send it to me two months beforehand please. We only have so much space, so certain events held outside our coverage area may not make the magazine.

7. How can I get extra exposure for my event? Take advantage of our extremely

low display rates. Clubs are finding out that it costs less to buy an ad than printing a bunch of flyers and spending hours distributing them.

8. Isn't this the same publication I used to read years ago? NO, it is not. This is the CRUISE GUIDE, not "letter". I started it from scratch,

not "letter". I started it from scratch, had no help from any other publication. I saw a need and filled it. Just say "Cruise Guide"

9. How do you make any money since it is FREE? Well, if you look at my

tax return, the easy answer is that I don't. The magazine is advertiser supported, which pays for the cost to print and distribute. Since the inception, the magazine has covered

my costs, but you can't make a living in print anymore, unless you own the printing plant. I did this to help the hobby, not line my pockets. Three years ago, we started the Upper Bay Boating magazine. Now that I have two publications sharing the expenses, I can now pay myself something out of the business. Basically semi-retired!

10. How do I get my car in the Readers Ride or my garage in the Man Cave?

Just contact Hutch or me, and we will make it happen. A publication like this can't exist without some participation from the readers. So please contact us anytime to submit story ideas, or show listings, and club news. Also, if you have to, more questions!















Foundation Update



Things Not To Do When You See A Hot Rod On The Road

If you cut it a little too close, you just taken our ability to see one step ahead we just talked about not to mention you could kick up road debris that could cause a trip to the painter or the glass shop

5. DO NOT MAKE US ROLL DOWN THE WINDOW TO ASK A QUESTION!

Someone once said "there are no stupid questions, only stupid people." I'm not sure about that, but I have certainly heard some dumb questions. 






The BMW GINA Light Visionary Madel was designed by Christopher Bangle and staff to consider consumers' immediate needs and desires in both styling and function. The Gina's shape could change through the use of flexible tensile fabric stretched over a movable body frame of



aluminum and flexible carbon fiber. When needed, the front headlamps would be exposed, and the tailights would shine through the fabric. The seats, steering wheel, head rest, and console automatically responded to each individual driver.

Production autumobiles require expensive tooling to form metal body panels. By making the GINA's body out of fabric, Bangle and his team sought a way to reduce tooling expenses and facilitate more frequent style changes.







Reader's Rides

Pete and Sandy Robinson's XR-7 Cougar

The car is a 1968 Mercury Cougar XR-7 hardtop. It was special ordered new by the original owner in April of 1968 from Fiore Lincoln Mercury in Altoona, PA. He specified Augusta green exterior color with saddle leather interior. The only options that he requested were an AM radio, console, and four speed manual transmission. Quite unusual for the upscale XR-7, as most were ordered with



power steering and brakes, automatic transmission, tinted glass, vinyl top, etc. In fact, according to the Marti report, of the 32,709 XR7's produced in 1968, only 530 were ordered with this particular engine and transmission combination.

The car was always garage kept, driven only sparingly, and upon his passing was put into storage and not driven from 1988 until 2007, when the second owner, also from Altoona, purchased the car from his family. At that time, the car was still wearing it's PA license plates with an expiration date of March 1988. When resurrecting the car from it's nearly 20 years of storage, the second owner saved all of the original maintenance items that he replaced, including the original tires, belts, air filter, thermostat, tune up parts, brake parts, etc.

We were able to purchase the car from the second owner in August of 2016 when he lost his indoor storage for the car. Up until that point the car had never left the Altoona, PA area.

The car to date has only 19,500 original miles, and retains it's original paint and interior, chrome, all of it's original numbers matching engine and driveline components (including the thermactor pump) and even it's original exhaust system and FOMOCO script headlight bulbs. It truly is a real time capsule.

It will be a special invitational display vehicle in Building T at the Carlisle All Ford Nationals as a part of the 50th Anniversary of the Mercury Cougar Celebration.


