




n March 3, 2018, Senator Wayne Norman of Harford and Cecil Counties passed on, joining many other cruisers on the heavenly roads.

Wayne was like any other guy; a family man, a lawyer by trade, a guy who loved trains and the Western MD Railway, and a car guy. He was very approachable and liked sharing the car hobby with all of us. As Rick Ladd told me, "Wayne never acted like a politician, he was just one of us. He was a fan of the Perryville Outlets Cruise that I had a few years back".

Wavne was a member of the MG's of Baltimore since 1989. I spoke to the President of the club. Mr. Richard Liddick, who told me that with Wayne's knowledge of the law, he was able to help the club become 'Incorporated' in 1991. Wayne then became their 'Resident Agent with the State of Maryland'.

Wayne loved the British classic cars and his stable was well repre-

sented with Land Rovers, Jaguars and MG's. He truly enjoyed taking his MG convertible to Road Rallies and on trips to Watkins Glen, NY, and Latrobe, PA to tour the Latrobe Brewing Company that made Rolling Rock Beer. After that tour, he decided to name his MG 'Rolling Rock' because the colors were so similar. Mr. Liddick said Wayne had very little time to tend to his cars, so they frequently broke down.

He was also a member, and encouraged every person in the car community to become a member, of the SEMA Action Network (semaSAN.com) that works to defend our hobby nationally on vehicle related legislation and regulations. Wayne was honored with the SEMA APPRECIA-TION AWARD in July, 2016.

While serving Maryland in the House of Delagates, Wayne was a member of the Motor Vehicle and Transportation Sub-Committee from 2008 - 2015. He pushed his

fellow law makers to write and pass better auto tag/registration laws. He wanted to make sure the vehicles were classified and tagged correctly, whether Antique/Historic or Street Rod. He was also instrumental in helping push through the "one time" or "50 year" tag law. This also eliminated the necessity for a front tag. Bill Bradley, a close friend of Wayne's told me Wayne always said "If you complain about you're tags, you're probably illegal". Wayne tried to obtain the ability for all of us to drive our cars for "occasional use", which didn't go over well with non-enthusiasts.

Dave Bielecki stated that "when I started the Car Show & Cruise Guide magazine, Wayne stepped right up and said he had my back and that of the hobby. Even though he was busy in Annapolis, he made time to come to my All Clubs Breakfast and share news and legislative updates with all our car guys and gals".

After Wayne was elected to the

Maryland Senate in 2014, Mr. Bielecki stated that "when a group of us got together and formed the 'Custom & Classic Car Educational Foundation', Wayne stepped up at the very beginning and drew up the paperwork to make sure we were a 501c3 non-profit organization because he cared so much for the hobby".

I asked Mr. Bielecki what he would miss most about Wayne and he said "his happy-go-lucky demeanor". Everyone I talked to for this article said they would miss his smile and sense of humor.

Senator Norman was appropriately taken for his final ride in Mr. Jerry Scarborough's 1949 Ford F-5 Flatbed. A very fitting "Last Ride" for our friend Wayne. Thank you, Jerry.

In closing, as Mr. Bielecki said, "his presence will sorely be missed and we will probably never have anyone else do so much to represent the car hobby in Annapolis".

Cuba was, of course, also the central stage for one of history's darkest hours, in 1962, when JFK learned that Castro's pals the Soviets were building missle bases there, the kind that have a nuke on top that could flatten any city in

and used cars for the very first time since the island country converted to communism in 1959 (how nice of them).

It's part of a push by the country's president, Raul Castro, to increase freedom for average citizens. Raul took over for his ailing brother, Fidel, in 2008 who has since died. (A moment of silence please, for the people he's killed).

Some imported vehicles may include a 100-percent tax, meant to fund Cuba's public transport system, according to the Communist

Party's newspaper, Granma. No, I'm not kidding, Granma.

The proposed changes put a greater emphasis on private initiative, which had been largely stifled under Cuba's Soviet-style system, and less government control over the sale and purchase of personal property such as homes and cars.

Mavbe Raul Castro and Cuba should rethink socialism, and finally ease into the ideas of capitalism, for the benefit of the country his brother "liberated" 54 years ago. China's doin' it, the

Ruskies are doin' it. Even the most recent attempt to "tranform" the U.S. to where the government runs and controls everything didn't work, either.

There is already a cottage industry there rebuilding generators, starters, distributors, etc and shops reconditioning cranks, camshafts, transmission & rear axle parts.

After all, they rust just as bad as they do here, being close to the sea, and they've been driving them for sixty years. But it's nice to see 'ole Raul coming around. 



## R.I.P. Ronald Fouse


