

During the production of this issue, Diane Bielecki, President of this publication suffered a stroke and was





Duncan Forster and Phil Weicker built their first tub-on-wheels as undergrads at McMaster University in Ontario, Canada. With a fellow student, they transformed an abandoned 1982 Chevy Malibu into a pool. "This thing was hideous," Forster says. "The car barely ran, but we were really proud of it." Twelve years later, living in Los Angeles, they bought a

Angeles, they bought a 1969 Cadillac DeVille and one-upped their beloved jalopy. The "Carpool DeVille" ran so well, Forster and Weicker set an even more ambitious goal: world's fastest hot tub. A successful Kickstarter campaign funded a trip to Utah's Bonneville Salt Flats for Speedweek 2014 in Bonneville, Utah, where it reached a top speed of 160 mph.



The Carpool De Ville, which uses its 472 V8 engine to heat the water in the passenger area to a temperature of 102 degrees, was awarded Guinness World Record status earlier this month, and became one of the most attention-grabbing vehicles to hit the auction block recently at the Barrett-Jackson event in Scottsdale. Despite a disclaimer on Barrett-Jackson's listing: "Vehicle cannot be registered or driven on any public roads," The car sold for \$26,400














The Davis Divan is a three-wheeled convertible built by the Davis Motorcar Company between 1947 and 1949. The brainchild of used-car salesman Glen Gordon "Gary" Davis, it was largely based upon "The Californian", a custom three-wheeled roadster built by future Indianapolis 500 racing car designer Frank Kurtis for Southern Californian millionaire and racer Joel Thorne. After building two prototypes in 1947, Davis embarked on an aggressive publicity and promotional campaign for the car,. At the company factory in Van Nuys, employees worked frantically to build Divans, although the model was never put into mass production. Despite raising \$1.2 million through the sale of 350 dealerships, the Davis Motorcar Company failed to deliver, and was ultimately sued. The company's assets were liquidated in order to pay back taxes, while Gary Davis himself was eventually convicted of fraud and grand theft and sentenced to two years. Only 13 Divans (including the two prototypes) were ever built, of which 12 have survived. The car featured aircraft-inspired styling details as well as disc brakes, hidden headlights, and built-in jacks.



Larry Borland's '68 Cougar

My Cougar was purchased in May of 2006 from a friend who was once turned away at a car show because it "wasn't a muscle car." Well, if it wasn't then, it is now, with the original 302 built into a 347 stroker with all the good stuff, and the C4 trans has been beefed up with a TCI street fighter equivalent with 6 planetaries. Original underpinnings have been replaced with a Mustang II-style rack and pinion, tubular A arms, which required removing the shock towers, oversize disc brakes and 17-inch wheels.




The interior has white face gauges and Mustang tach. The steering wheel is a custom piece in which I added the "Mercury Man" insignia out of a luxury Merc.

I did all the research on all the parts, supplied the mechanical work, welding (and the money!)

My friend Ray Quinn powdercoated the axle to match the body, which still sports the original paint. (The red Impala in the photo is one of his many toys).

The car turned out just like intended, with a bit

Out back, I used a 9-inch rear out of a Lincoln Versailles, using just the housing and axles. New 350 gears, Tru-Track Posi, and Chevy disc brakes round out the package.

I modified a Mustang 4-link suspesion (the Cougar is 3 inches longer), and added coil over shocks and sway bars.
