


And lastly, the number one thing you can do to help the success of the Cruise Guide and thus, the hobby....

Road Trip!

Kelly and Ed Beard Jr.'s Journey to SEMA with the "Dragonlord"

Part One

Dragonlord is a 2000 custom dodge van that started life as a basic cargo van painted by my husband Ed.

The Dragonlord was invited as a featured vehicle at SEMA 2018. We wanted this to be an epic adventure for our van and share the story of the artwork and the artist with others along

the way. With over 600 hours in muralling alone, there was a lot of story to share and driving the van a total of over 5,000 miles, we would have a lot of people to share the story with.

RIO SHOP

Our road trip began from our home in Central PA, taking I-81 South to I-40 West with a destination of Nevada. Our first goal was to 'just get there' and though we saw some amazing country on the way, we stayed the 2700 mile course without many stops. However, we recommend more frequent stops to minimize driver strangulation, (lol). The Dragonlord

behaved as it roared on down the road. There were many thumbs up, honking of horns and vehicles flanking us to get some great photos.

As we got closer to Nevada at a fill up in Texas, we met up with a former vanner whose nickname, not kidding, was 'Beard'. He spent time taking pictures of the Dragonlord and reminiscing on past days when he had his custom van. We wouldn't be surprised if he went home and started a new van project. While giving the van a much needed bath, the Dragonlord was inundated with lots more fans, photos and new friends, including other builders heading to SEMA.

We had a bit of a bump in the road when we reached Kingman, AZ when we realized we had too much gas in the tank to be able to enter the conven-















tion lot. With some help from a fellow vanner as well as a service tech at AutoZone, gas was emptied, shared with others who needed it – kismet events are amazing sometimes. We chatted for a little bit with a gentleman, names Wayne, who had a '92 Ford van and had always been thinking of painting it and felt inspired, then hit the road for the last stretch.

The Dragonlord was definitely treated like a star at SEMA, the only fully wrap around airbrushed muraled van ever to show there. We met some incredible people, talked until our voices were hoarse and started trending on social media with all the photos attendees were taking. Ed was interviewed by numerous magazines, online and cable shows and lots of business cards were shared. After the final parade into the SEMA Ignited show and a chance to drive the Dragonlord passed thousands of fans, it was time to make the journey home.

We followed Route 66 on our way home and took time to see the sights and meet some great folks. We stopped back in Kingman, AZ for the night and could not believe our eyes when we met up with Wayne again who had indeed painted his van and was so happy to show us. Had a long conversation in the parking lot of a supermarket with 'Jaguar Joe', a young father who loved cars, his family and just needed someone to talk to that understood being home, close to family and watching your children grow up makes you more rich than money ever could – another moment that Lady Fate had in the cards for us. The Dragonlords murals and ominous appearance was the catalyst or neutral ground that seemed to make everyone who saw it want to share a story.




A Plea by Dave-
















Club Wews





Johnny Pappas' 1957 Chevy Bel Air

"Belle

The year was 1957, a year when America was booming - more than ten years after the end of World War II when morale was at its lowest. The automobile industry in particular, was enjoying robust sales and Chevrolet was no exception with its big success in developing the famous small block engine and revamping its Chevrolet line-up with the tremendously popular 1955 Chevrolet Bel Air- a radical change in style from the previous year. Chevrolet again duplicated that success the following year with the 1956 Chevrolet Bel Air incorporating a few small changes but nothing ground shaking that would wow the car consumer like the 55 Chevy.


1957 was a whole other story. I had just turned six when the unveiling of the newly designed 57 Chevy Bel Air immortalized that year as the year that churned out a future American Icon. The never before seen chrome fins combined with a reshaped rear and front end elicited pure excitement among car enthusiasts – my father being one of them. He exclaimed to us (my mother, sister and I) one morning over a typical breakfast of bacon, buttered toast and coffee that he just had to have a new 1957 Chevy Bel Air. Buying a cool car like that would put an end to our next door neighbor Max Steiner's boastful tales of his newish 1955 Chevrolet that dad painfully saw every morning and night as he left and came home from work.

After test driving a 1957 Larkspur Blue and white Chevrolet Bel Air 4 door sedan just delivered to the dealer, Dad bought it and although the paint was like looking into a mirror - I never had to be coerced into washing it or giving it a fresh coat of wax. As a wide-eyed youngster, I fell in love with that 57 Chevy as every boy interested in cars would with its chromed fins and huge "eyes" that served as headlights. Seven blissful years passed driving the 57 (my father nicknamed the Chevy Blue Cloud while my mother named it pain in the ass because turning the manual steering wheel took every ounce of her strength!) to many surrounding states on vacation. Over the years, my father's enchantment turned into disillusion. One part after another gave up on Blue Cloud (now nicknamed Storm Cloud!) and Dad, after having enough, begrudgingly traded in his beloved 57 Bel Air for a new 1964 red & white Pontiac Catalina. As we left the dealership, I gave our family icon one last touch on one of the fins, lamenting its departure while thinking my chances of owning the family Tri-five was lost that hot, summer day. Thoroughly crushed at thirteen years old. I vowed to one day own one just like it someday.

Fast forward to 2009 – my wife and I traveled to Fredericksburg VA for a classic car and bike show in which we were going to enter my 1968 BSA motorcycle (I am the original owner but that's another story!). All day rain cancelled the show, but not before we talked to an elderly couple who bought a 1940 Chevy Masters to the show. They bragged it was fully modernized and could go to California in pure comfort. On the way home, I told my wife we

would buy a 57 Chevy Bel Air and do the same with it as the old couple did. Now, instead of taking two to three years to find the 57 of my dreams as I told my wife it would take – I found my the car of my dreams that night with her help on Craig's list, a mere eighteen miles from our home. The owner bought the 57 Chevy Bel Air 2 dr hardtop for his wife's 50th birthday but when he unveiled it in a restaurant parking lot, her mouth dropped open as she hollered, "what the hell is that?...I want a 2010 Camaro!" So 57 Chevy was sold to us and right from the start, she proved to be a lemon. While driving her home on a chilly, frost laden, fall night followed by my wife,

I went to push the lever down marked heat, it came off in my hand and it was apparent, the blower motor was caput. Add to that, no horn, very dim headlights, a worn suspension system, down to the floor manual brakes, manual steering coupled



The next morning, "Belle" (the name I christened her after learning her original owner bought her from a dealer in the south) had no fewer than seven leaks underneath her on my newly tiled garage floor (adding insult to injury!) At that point, I seriously considered changing her name to "Lemonada".

During the next four years, many hours of knuckle busting wrenching, and money was poured into Belle. Friends and I did what we could in addition to farming her out for bigger tasks that needed a lift, tools and/or knowledge and skills we didn't have. This proved to be daunting as I found out there are few really good mechanics that know how to work on a classic car. After being totally fed up with ineptness, I brought her back home and once again tackled some of the work myself. She was now very close to having what I wanted; Classics Instruments cluster pod, new front and rear suspension, power steering, four wheel power disc brakes, A/C, retro radio with ten CD changer, new ZZ4 GM 350 crate engine, new 700R4 overdrive transmission, new Ford 9" 3.73 rear, custom fabricated 3" exhaust pipes from the Hooker super competition headers to the Chevy bowtie exhaust tips, a Holly 4 bbl 670 Avenger carb, an Edlebrock RPM performer air gap intake manifold, Billet Specialty SLG aluminum mag wheels, Griffin cross flow radiator, and a set of Mickey Thompson Sportsman flame tread radial tires with 28 x12's to fill out the newly mini-tubed rear wheel wells.

Belle had now morphed into a car that had old school looks with modern technology. All she needed now was a fresh coat of paint.....or so I thought. In October 2013, I took her to an auto body shop in Stafford, Virginia to complete her transformation with some minor body work and fresh paint. But, after stripping her down to bare metal, my wife and I got the bad news –Belle's quarters, rocker panels, floor pans and the whole trunk was either rusted out or

full of bondo. So what was to be a few, short months of undergoing a new paint job , turned out to be almost a full year of anxious, nail biting before Belle returned home. But much to my dismay, many big and small "bugs" surfaced during the next year that had to be addressed from the lack of detail in putting her back together. After another year of fixing two dozen problems – Belle was finally deemed safe and fully functional.

Now, finally, Belle is my dream car that has become a reality. No trailer queen, my wife and I drive her for over three hours to car shows in rain (not when we can help it!) or shine. And we adhere to one strict rule while cruising in her – only fifties rock & roll and Doo Wop is played on her CD/radio. In this respect, Belle is our time machine enabling us to go back to simpler times when all one had to think about was what to order at the local car hop drive-in! Dreams DO come true!
