

George Barris' work back in the '50s probably comes closest to crowning him the King of Kustoms. Most folks think of the *Batmobile* when they think of Barris, but

closest to crowning him the King of Kustoms. Most folks think of the *Batmobile* when they think of Barris, but Bill Carr's 1955 Chevrolet, dubbed "Aztec" is a car that put Barris on the map in 1958 and it has been on quite a journey before landing on Mecum Auction block this January. Our Senior photographer Bill Ross is old enough to remenber how important to custom history this car is, so he traveled to Kissemmee to see and possibly bid on the car.

Starting with a new '55 Chevy, Barris, owner Bill Carr, Bruce Douglas, and another mutual friend with a very similar name, Bill DeCarr, transformed the car into a glistening copper/tangerine chariot, carefully blending styling tweaks and nuances borrowed from late-model cars of the day.

Among the mods were quad headlight bezels from a '57 Mercury Tumpike Cruiser, pancaked hood and deck, '53 Studebaker lower grille pans with custom bumpers combining '57 DeSoto, '57 Olds, and '49 Chevrolet pieces. George's brother **Sam Barris**

chopped the windshield roughly 3.5 inches, with a "DeVille-style" lift-off Carson top. Carson's **Bob Houser** was also responsible for the Naugahyde and frieze fabric upholstery.

One day, a man from Arizona plunked down the cash to buy both the **Aztec** and a Porsche

that belonged to pinstriper **Dean Jeffries**. Unbeknownst to the sellers, he financed his purchases by robbing banks back east. It wasn't long before he was apprehended, and the *Aztec* was confiscated and eventually auctioned off. Then it was spotted in a Rod & Custom ad by Virginia customizer **Sunny Daout** who did extensive bodywork. In 1967, drag racer and car show promoter



legendary show car. So, when the incomplete original landed in his garage, all the components he'd been collecting gave him a bit of a head start on the restoration.

Still, it was a herculean effort. At the time, he was still living in New Jersey and had partnered with body shop owner **Bob Nitti** on the project. Nitti replaced the floors, quarter panels, and rockers, and he and Barry installed new doors and hand-crafted the sculpted cruiser skirts. Nitti also began restoring the rest of the custom work DeCarr and Carr originally completed 60 years prior.

By 1994, the bodywork was far enough along that Barry was able to coat it in primer for an appearance at the Lead East custom car show in Parsippany, New Jersey that year. Then, in '95, he relocated to Fort Pierce, Florida, where the restoration would be completed. The car was expected to bring a quarter of a million dollars, but it moved to the "bid goes on" at 200K.



The 1968 Ford Mustang Bullitt GT

driven by Steve McQueen in Hollywood's legendary action film of the same name emerged to international celebration after being hidden in a family's garage for 40 years. Now, after touring America and the world for two years, the pony car has been sold to an anonymous bidder for a record \$3.4 miliion dollars. The New Jersey detective who sold the storied car to Robert Kiernan, then a 26-year-old insurance executive, said Kiernan was the only person who responded to the Road & Track magazine ad that touted a McQueen film connection "with documentation."

Sean Kiernan, who put his father's beloved Highland Green Mustang on the Mecum auction block in Kissimmee, Florida, on Jan 10 explained that he had auction bidding start at just \$3,500 because that's what his father paid for the vehicle in 1974.

With the public unveiling of the vehicle in 2018 at the Detroit auto show, **Mark Gessler**, president of the Historic Vehicle Asso-



ciation, told the Free Press, "This is probably the most important artifact of the 20th century in terms of automotive history. It is a national cultural treasure.

Chrysler's new altered wheelbase Hemi cars hit the strip in 1964, and they dominated in A/FX as expected and were an instant sensation. One of the best known was the '65 Dodge Coronet of Dave Strickler, who passed away in 1985. By the end of 1965, both Strickler and Jenkins were back with Chevrolet, ending their short two-year run with Chrysler. The Strickler car would end up in the hands of Chuck McJury of Syracuse, New York, shown here at Cecil Dragway in 1966, before it disappeared. With a lot of diligent work and some luck, Steve Atwell, Dick Towers, and Jim Kramer together chased down multiple leads before eventually finding the car in a chicken coop. Atwell was able to acquire the racer and brought it back to it's former glory before it took up residence in the Chrysler Museum in Detroit.



4 speed trans.,4 carburetor engines rated at 140hp. There were trucked in and parked in a field behind the dealership. They were converted to the Stinger theme there. Don and some race friends figured the Corvair would be a great contender for the SCCA D/ Production road



My car was fully restored in 2013 at Pritz Body Shop in York, where I live. We worked nights and weekends on it. It was primered, base coat in white and two coats of Ermine white, blue stripes and accents. Two coats of clear and many hours of buffing. Body work was done by Kurt Jones, panting by Jesus Lopez and engine by Dan Heckel. Two years ago I added the original English Minilite wheels, all aluminum and very light. At

many shows I usually have to explain the story about the Stinger history. You just don't see them around and the people who have one do not sell them. The car has one many awards which adds to the enjoyment and fun of displaying it. Looking forward to the upcoming car show season......

race class. Which was dominated by Triumph TR-4 cars. The first hundred fleet cars were built in December 1965 and had a special body tag then given a Stinger aluminum tag which was put on the drivers door jamb that read YENKO STINGER YS-001 to YS-100 and Cannonsburg, Pa. In 1967 A Stinger won the National championship in D/P.

He later built 25 1967 Corvairs and they were painted red or blue with white stripes and accents. They were numbered YS-101 to YS-125. There were no YS-200 tags used. Later also he built cars or converted owners Corvairs that used the YS-300 to YS-320. My Stinger was a later built version that has my YS-313 tag on it. There only 186 Stingers ever built, making them a RARE breed of cars!! Most of the original 100 cars were sold for road racing, only a small percentage were sold in street trim.


