
Tom loves being at this end of the hobby and collecting things that a lot of people may have never seen before. The parts for these early Mopar a-bodies are still pretty available

# Tom Rosso's 1965 Chrysler Valiant AP6 Wayfarer Utility UTE

This UTE was assembled in Adelaide Australia along with Valiant Station Wagons, and four door sedans. In this name designation the AP signifies "Australian Production", and the word Wayfarer meaning "to go far". Records indicate that there were only 4423 of these made. The only engine option was the 225 cu in slant six producing a whopping 145 hp. In the day, most of these vehicles

were purchase by farmers who used them hard and unfortunately a lot of them were left to rot in the outback. They have become increasingly popular with the Aussie Mopar fans who themselves are having a hard time finding salvageable Utes to restore.

I had been looking to import an Ap6 Utility to complete my nine car Valiant collection but then was lucky enough to purchase one several years ago right here in the States from The Bayer Boys in Georgia. At the time it was thought to be the only one here in the US. That Ute is currently on a rotisserie undergoing a full and much needed restoration. Then on a tip from an Australian Facebook friend in April of 2019, I was told of an AP6 Ute located in Texas that had come up for sale. I had seen a random car show pic of the





Ute online but had no idea where it was. I contacted the seller, negotiated the deal, and brought it to Maryland. Even though it had apparently sold at Barrett-Jackson sometime around 2006, it was obvious that the car had sat out and was neglected for years. The interior was rough, the slant six was shot (which is hard to do), and the transmission was slipping. This one time show car needed some love.

Over the next twelve weeks we did a full restoration to the mechanics on the car. We pulled and rebuilt the engine and transmission. All brake hardware and lines as well as gas tank, fuel lines and shocks were done. A true Australian Valiant radiator was located and brought over. Interior was freshened up and freshly chromed trim bits were installed. The good part is that most of the parts are interchangeable with our American vintage Valiant's and Barracudas from '64-'66 except for those items that are right hand



drive specific. The exterior was buffed and buffed again. We debuted the Ute at the Chrysler Carlisle Nationals in July 2019 and were satisfied in knowing it was the first AP6 Ute to ever do so. While not a show car, it shows pretty well from 20' and is something that most people have never seen!


