Tim Casey's '54 Half-Ton Chevy Truck


I am a 37 year old from Oaks, Pennsylvania and I've been wrenching on cars with my dad as long as I can remember. I have always liked the 47-55 Chevy ÅD trucks, but never liked the original state of them.. slow and riding rough... I have always dreamed to have one of those trucks that was a driver that's fun and fast using modern technology.

I don't have a garage big enough to work in, so this would have to be tackled outside in my driveway. Which was fine for me, because I wanted a truck

that can be driven, used and enjoyed and not sit under cover only to come out a few times a year.

I bought this 54 1/2 ton in the end of May 2018. It was a one-owner Maryland truck stored for 20 years until the owner's death in 1998 (at 98 years old.!)

Suspension was modified with a boxed frame using tubular Mustang II independent front suspension with coil overs, TCI front suspension setup with



power steering rack, and adjustable sway bar) In the rear is TCI parabolic rear leaf springs. I scratch built the entire exhaust and welded it

up with side

exit exhaust,

replaced front floors, both inner and outer cab corners, both front lower cowls, patch worked the bed and tubbed the rear. Painted here and sanded there to make it all look like it was originally an Arizona barn find with no rust. Bed wood is composite with aluminium strips, and a new 19 gallon tank under there. The wheels are Riddler 695's 18x8 225/45zr front and 18x9.5 255/45zr rear.

The interior features interior reclining TMI bench seat, new auto custom carpet, all new


headliner, kick panels, doors panels, all new glass, 32" tilt steering column, Hurst short throw shifter, Dakota digital VHX gauges, volante leather steering wheel, retro sound radio, dyna matter the inside of the truck, custom made cup holders (used old ac Delco oil filters with a timing chain, clutch fork (mounted a screen on the clutch fork as a back up camera) Subaru WRX clutch/ brake pedal assembly, booster and master cylinder completely stripped off every single wire and completely rewired the entire truck front to back.

I literally did EVERYTHING to this truck, paint and all, 100% by myself in five months. (OK– my wife helped me install the windshield and she helped me carry the bed off the frame and put it back on...)

I don't own a shop/garage, but I am very proud of the truck, so I made a stencil of our last name on the sides of the doors to make it look like a old shop truck as a finishing touch.


