I found this car nearly twenty-five years ago in the *Autotrader* magazine, before online selling was commonplace.

It is a Pennsylvania car, a 1948 body using a 1950 front nose, built by the seller back when Pro-Street, Monochromatic, and Dare-to-be-Different were the trends in the world of street rods.



The interior is fairly stock with a backseat. It has been mini-tubbed in back, and is powered by a 355 Chevy with a 871 B&M Supercharger. A four-speed sends the approximately 400 horsepower to a Ford nine-inch rear with 3:89 gears so it can be driven anywhere.

I have four other cars that I tend to drive more than the Stude, maybe because it's the one that's a little scary to drive – it has the stone-stock chassis underneath, drum brakes and all!



The Stude was on our April '15 cover when it was spotted at the now-gone Muscle Car Madness at York Fairsgrounds on "National Collector Car Appreciation Day" that year.

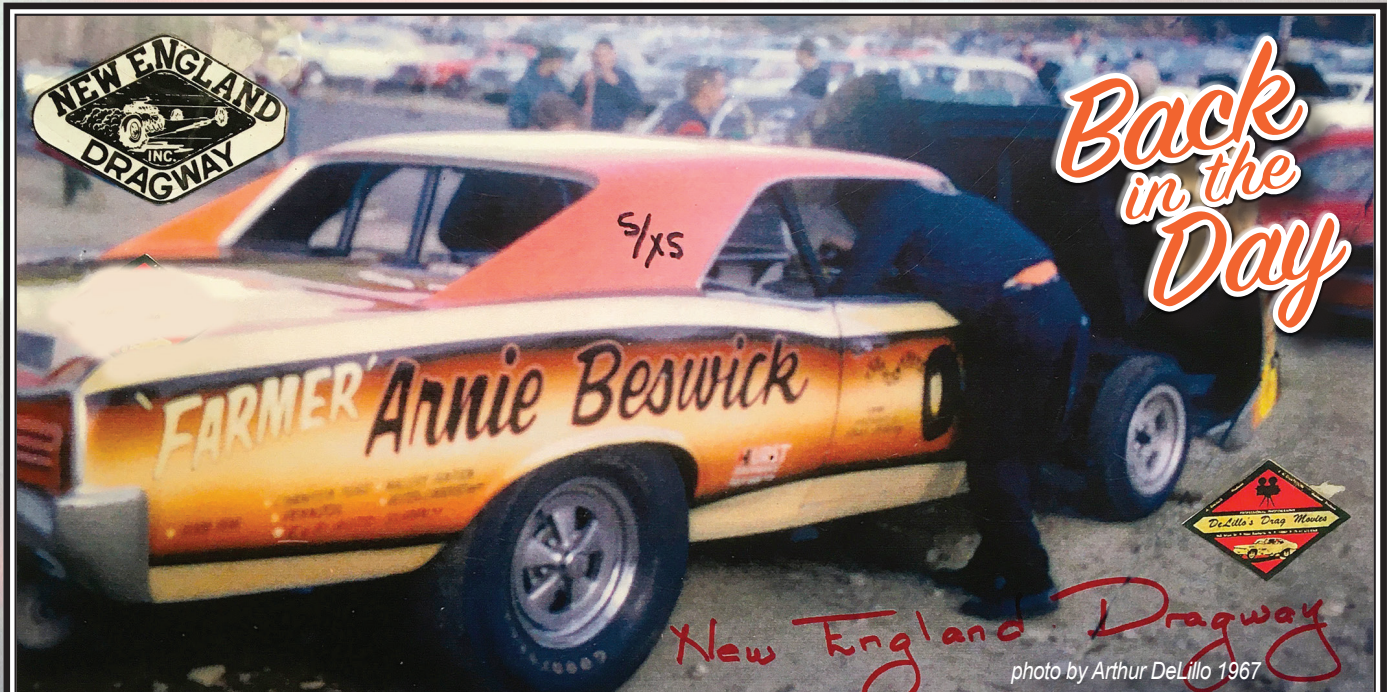

Through a series of Pontiac Catalina Super Dutys, GTOs and later, Trans Ams, **Arnie Beswick** always remained a force to be reckoned with. His 1963 Tempest had both the front and rear wheels moved forward almost a foot. The supercharged crowd pleaser astounded fans as it ran the quarter mile doing wheel stands to half track. By 1966, the altered wheelbase cars were in full swing, and Arnie needed to stay competitive. He lacked the resources that sponsorship provided, so, after borrowing the majority of the frame from a '64 GTO and adding to it a tube axle, he built a fiberglass bodied 1966 GTO. The "Funny Car" category continued to gain in popularity, and the Goat was a crowd pleaser everywhere it went. After several appearances, the announcers attached the moniker of "Star of the Circuit" to the multi-colored, eye catching GTO.

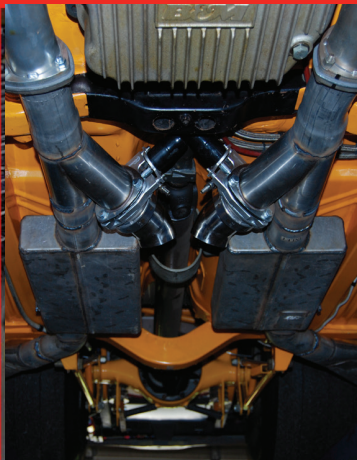

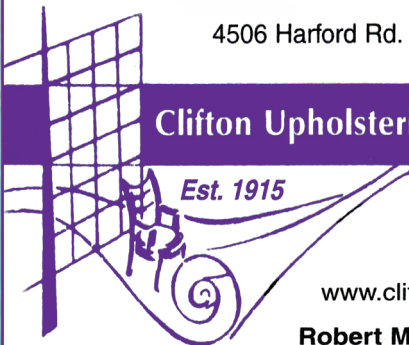

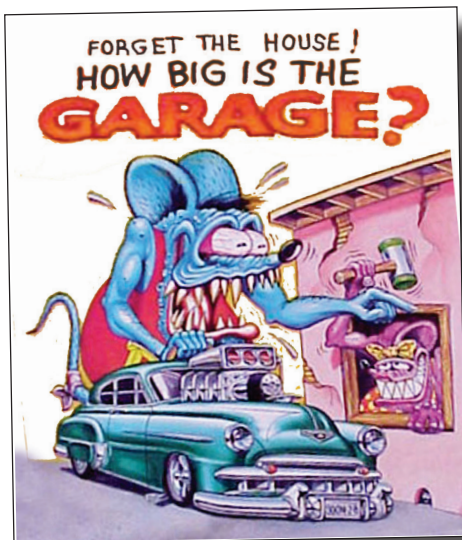
