 $T^{\text{he first stationary gasoline engine developed by}} \\ \text{Carl Benz was a one-cylinder two-stroke unit}$ which ran for the first time on New Year's Eve 1879. Benz had so much commercial success with this engine that he was able to devote more time to his dream of creating a lightweight car powered by a gasoline engine, in which the chassis and engine formed a single unit. The major features of the two-seater vehicle, which was completed in 1885. were the compact high-speed single-cylinder four-stroke engine installed horizontally at the rear, the tubular steel frame, the differential and three wire-spoked wheels. The engine output was 0.75 hp (0.55 kW). Details included an automatic intake slide, a controlled exhaust valve, high-voltage electrical vibrator ignition with spark plug, and water/thermo siphon evaporation cooling.

On January 29, 1886, Carl Benz applied for a patent for his "vehicle powered by a gas engine." The patent – number 37435 – may be regarded as the birth certificate of the automobile. In July 1886, the newspapers reported on the first public outing of the three-wheeled Benz Patent Motor Car, Model no. 1.

Using an improved version and without her husband's knowledge. Benz's wife Bertha and their two sons Eugen (15) and Richard (14) embarked on the first long-distance journey in automotive history on an August day in 1888.



The route included a few detours and took them from Mannheim to Pforzheim, her place of birth. With this journey of 180 kilometers including the return trip Bertha Benz demonstrated the practicality of the motor vehicle to the entire world. Without her daring – and that of her sons – and the decisive stimuli that resulted from it. the subsequent growth of Benz & Cie. in Mannheim to become the world's largest automobile plant of its day.



Tom Childers Dodge Charger Super UTE

Tom & Doll Childers Super Bee UTE started out as a 2007 Charger, and was transformed into what would become a modern Chrysler brand El Camino or Ranchero. Way down under in Australia, UTE's were extremely popular, but production has recently ceased from GM. The only way to have one these days is to build your own. That's exactly what Tom & Doll did. Being a Chevy guy, Tom owns a 2011 Chevy Caprice Police Cruiser

he bought new that was never in service. Loving the ride and power of his PPV, he looked into getting a GM Holden brand Statesman G8 Ute, but found out its near impossible to import to the states. So he found out about the Rhode Island Company making these kits.

Starting with a 2007 Super Bee SRT-8, they bought a Smyth Performance kit to transform their everyday ride into a UTE. The finished product looks like it came directly from Chrysler. Once you carefully make the first cut on your perfectly fine Charger, there is no turning back. Everything past the front seats is removed except the chassis and drive-line. About 50-70 hours later, their





ride was transformed into a very unique vehicle that steals all the attention at local shows. Tom hired Scott of Bagshaw's Hot Rod Fabrication to do most of the heavy lifting. The shop is located in Nascar country in North Carolina. After taking care of rust on the roof due to the weather in Florida where the car originated, Scott took the Sawzall to the Charger, then started putting all the well-engineered parts together. The car is stronger and lighter than before.

The kit from Smyth includes almost everything you need for the transformation. So many people have built Charger, VW Jetta & Beetles, Audi, Subaru, and Jeep UTEs that there are groups of owners with help and suggestions to make the job an easy one. Kits start around \$3000 and if you are handy and do your own work, you can have one of the most attention catching cars at your show for less than five grand, (plus the cost of the donor vehicle). Some can be picked up for about a grand. I suggest you start out with the very best donor car you can afford, as I did when I built the Bed Bug a few years ago.

The car was built to take on the Hot Rod Power Tour in 2020, which of course is delayed. I first laid eyes on it and met the couple at Carlisle for the National Chrysler Show. Tom & Doll have become friends and I just cannot get their beautiful UTE off my mind. It makes my Bed Bug look so tame! Maybe one day I'll take the leap and build my own Charger UTE.

Reader's Rides

Craig Conaway's '72 Ford Pinto

After restoring a black '63 1/2 Ford Galaxie, I set my sights on an early model Pinto to build with a V8. But whenever I would come across a likely candidate, it was overpriced, overrusted, or "sold yesterday".

Owning a '72 Pinto in the early '70's while serving in the Air Force, I wanted to build one with, as Tim Taylor would say, "more power". As fate would have it, while sitting at the inlet during the 2018

Endless Summer Cruise in Ocean City, Maryland, a Pinto was spied by my buddy coming off the boardwalk parade with a "for sale" sign. Once he parked in the inlet, we talked a bit, and on Friday evening I trailered it home since I was there with my Galaxie.

He had bought it from a man in New York who

had built it with his son, including the current paint scheme. Taking it to New Jersey, he replaced the old, tired 302 with a 302 H.O. from a '93 Mustang. He added a mild street cam, Edelbrock RPM aluminum



terminating at a Ford ,9" rear with 3.73 gears. It had Ansen Sprints like my old '72 had. Not a daily driver, but I didn't buy it for it's gas mileage. But it does get plenty of "smiles-per-gallon".

The Pinto received a lot of bad press regarding their "exploding" gas tanks, but with 3,173,492 Pinto's sold, less then 30 caught fire resulting from rear

end collisions, and was singled out by Nader & company. Other vehicles were just as susceptible to "explode", and did, but Pintos were the witchhunt target.

Many folks have fond memories of owning a Pinto, be it a sedan, Runabout, or a wagon. At car shows they tell me, "My Pinto didn't look like that!" This year marks the Ford Pinto's 50th Anniversary.



Ford's drag racing big hitters like Bill Lawton received these fiberglass wonders, with an additional 16-inches added ahead of the windshield, with a 15-inch engine setback for the 427 SOHC Cammer/C-6 automatic combo. There were six crafted in all from out of the Holman-Moody shop in Long Beach, California. Because there was no Funny Car class, NHRA slotted them into the C/Fuel class where they completely dominated. These would be the last factory-sponsored drag racing entries until the Cobra Jet Mustangs debuted in 1968.
