Bob Klein and Mike Schatzmann's 1929 Chevy "PA Hillbillies" Truck

In 1985, Jim Groff's son saw a 1929 Chevrolet for sale in Dallas, Texas. The car was all metal and had most of its parts. The price of the vehicle was listed as \$1500. Jim figured it couldn't be much of a car for that price but decide to go down with his son to purchase the vehicle as a project that that they could work on.

The car was in pieces but all the metal seemed to be there as well as the chassis. Jim and his son rented a trailer and gathered the cars parts and brought everything back to Christiana, Pa., to begin the project.

The car was in need of an engine, so Jim searched and found a 1930 Chevrolet engine locally. When he contacted the owner he was told the engine had

been sitting outside in the weather for 20 years, but had a piece of tin covering it. Jim bought the engine for \$75 and transported it back to his workshop where he found that engine had seized up.

They pulled the plugs and cleaned them, put WD 40 into each cylinder, pulled the oil drain plug to find a mix of water and oil





draining from the pan, and found the carburetor full of water.

After several hours of soaking the cylinders with WD 40 and many attempts to turn the engine by hand, they managed to get the flywheel to turn one complete rotation.

Not long after, the engine began rolling easier when turning over by hand. They began cleaning the rest of the components and

put gas into the engine and had it running within 3 hours. It sputtered and coughed but it was operational.

Several days later, the car was rolling down the streets of Christiana, Pa. on its own power. Several of Jim's friends thought the car should be made up as a Hillbilly Truck; and it made its initial appearance as The Hillbilly Truck in the Christiana Halloween Parade.

After the initial appearance, the car was entered into its first car show. No official knew what class to have the car registered. The car began making its car show rounds over the years. During that time, money was made for the Lions Club by having people have their pictures taken beside the car for donations. The money was donated to the Lions for the Blind Children.

In July 1994, the car was driven to the 25th Street Rod Nationals held in St. Louis, II from Christiana, Pa. The trip took two weeks and the engine (same one that was frozen up in 1985) only used $\frac{1}{2}$ qt. of oil.

Around 1996, Jim and the "Hillbilly" crew had so much fun over the past few years driving and raising money for the Lions Club, that they decided it was time to make plans to drive the truck out to where the Clampet's had settled.... Beverly Hill, Ca. In June 1999, extra parts were loaded into a Dodge Pickup truck (additional engine, rear end, front end, starter, and tires) and the truck was ready to drive along with the Hillbilly truck out west. The idea was to put the back wheels into the Atlantic and begin the trip. The car made it to New Jersey, where a wheel bearing gave out. It had to be replaced by a Dodge Wheel bearing where a picture was taken with the Twin Towers in the background. What became apparent after reviewing the picture was the sign in the background... "Nude Beach."

While in the area, the Hillbilly Truck was parked outside of the "Today Show" location. While parked there, Al Roker, the weatherman got out of his limousine and had a puzzled look on his face when he saw the truck parked there. Not long after, he emerged from the building to give the weather forecast while standing beside the truck and interviewed the Hillbilly Crew as he asked questions about the truck and the trip.


During the trip the car was on 21 Television News Stations across the country. The car broke down several times with the most notable breakdown in the Grand Canyon.

While driving a loud banging sound was heard under and in back of the driver's seat. The wooden floorboards were pulled and the transmission cover was removed. No apparent damage was found in the transmission. It was decide to pull into a small

town not far away that had only one garage. The owner of the garage stated that he had heard them coming for a few miles, but they were about to close and that the truck would be looked at in the morning.

After jacking the car up, 5 Navajo Indian mechanics checked everything under the car and found the problem in the rear end. Two teeth had broken off the Ring Gear. At a much earlier time (before 1985) work had been done to the rear end and non-standard parts had been used in the repair. It was easily determined that trying to find a ring gear in the Grand Canyon for a vintage truck would be not be an easy task. The owner of the garage mentioned that there was a Navajo Indian that might be able to weld the teeth back onto the Ring Gear. The Hillbilly crew was skeptical but had







no choice other than to let the welder try. The repair was made. That car made noise but could be driven. The mechanics decide that their time repairing and troubleshooting would be donated so the Truck could continue the journey. Only the parts were charge... \$55.00 for 2 days work by 5 mechanics and a welder.

Over a period of time on the trip, the teeth wore themselves in that same Ring Gear is still in the rear end today! It has never been removed or replaced.

59 days after beginning the journey across country, the

Hillbilly Truck put the front wheels into the Pacific Ocean after passing through Beverly Hills.

The truck remained dormant after the 1999 trip until it was purchased by Bob Klein and Mike Schatzmann several years ago. The vehicle was checked out and items added to make it look as it does today. It has made many appearances Parades and local car shows as well as appearing in New Jersey, Delaware, and Maryland. The spirit of the vehicle remains the same as we try to raise money

for Veterans Organizations (VFW, American Legion, Wreaths across America) and local charities, by asking for a \$5 dollar donation to sign the car.

In its' history, the vehicle has managed to acquire over \$40,000 in donations for the Lions Club and Veterans Groups as the Hillbilly Clan continues to travel to various locations having fun and raising money for those in need.




