





fee yourself, that would be wonderful! Dave is including a copy of the registration form on the facing page for you non-techies to use. Fill it out in it's entirety and forward it to the address indicated along with your payment. We are looking forward to an incredibly successful event... We hope to see you there!

I've mentioned before that there are some clubs in the area that have committed funds to the foundation from the proceeds of their car shows. The Chesapeake region of the AACA, the Buick owners of Maryland and the Freestate region of the Vintage Chevrolet Club of America are all hosting events in the very near future. Mark Schappell's 1986 Monte Carlo

My 1986 Chevrolet Monte Carlo SS was originally bought by a family member, who drove it as his daily driver for it's first six years. After purchasing a truck for work, he was only driving it for a few hundred miles a year. Then he needed more room in the garage...Knowing I loved the Monte's. Knowing I would take care of it, he finally offered it to me in 2000 for \$3,500. I jumped on it so fast, he might have thought he could have sold it to

someone else for more. Garage kept it entire life and totally original except the Alpine AM/FM/cassette stereo. One of a few ordered in dark maroon with the available gray interior. It



was repainted in 1992 due to peeling of the clear coat as many in the 80's and early 1990's vehicles did. He thought the car looked good without the strip package, so that's how it stayed. I agreed, I like the clean look.

But as always, a bump in the road...I wasn't sure I could continue with my plans as my wife had a stroke a few months into the job. After ten days in the hospital and home, the therapy started. Improving everyday, but not able to work. She's still with me and that means the world to me. I felt I had to stop the project due to new challenges and thoughts of cash flow. But, she wanted it done cause she knew what the car meant to me. She has enjoyed road trips, going to to shows and Ocean City.

Since the motor replacement, new Dakota Digital VHX gauges (sensor calibrations by Maryland Performance), Kenwood CD/Bluetooth receiver and Kicker speakers were installed. Front end suspension updated with Detroit Speed 2" lowering kit, Ridler 695 wheels. Rear (18x9) & front (17x8.5). New cowl hood, new dark maroon metallic paint with ghost rallies by Eddie Evans at the Maaco shop in Dundalk, MD. Interior is still original except headliner and sun visors, so my next project could be new carpet and who knows... maybe leather seats ?!? Maybe Holley Sniper or Edelbrock Pro-Flo 3 EFI.

As I go to many shows, shooting photos for the Car Cruise Guide. I enjoy driving and showing my ride, happy to receive an occasional trophy amongst many beautiful cars, and trucks. I'm honored to be around many good friends and my best friend, my wife Lorri. Thanks for everything!!










In Memoriam 6 Roger Pritt Bill Hoover Phil Whalen






