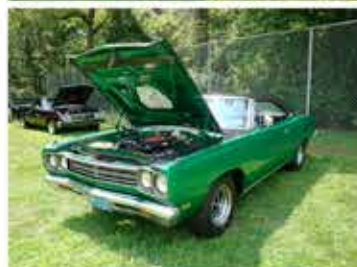
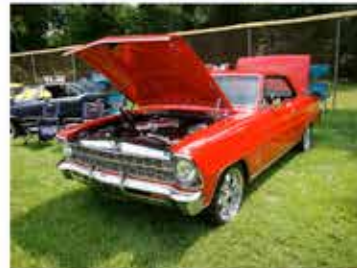


Bombers

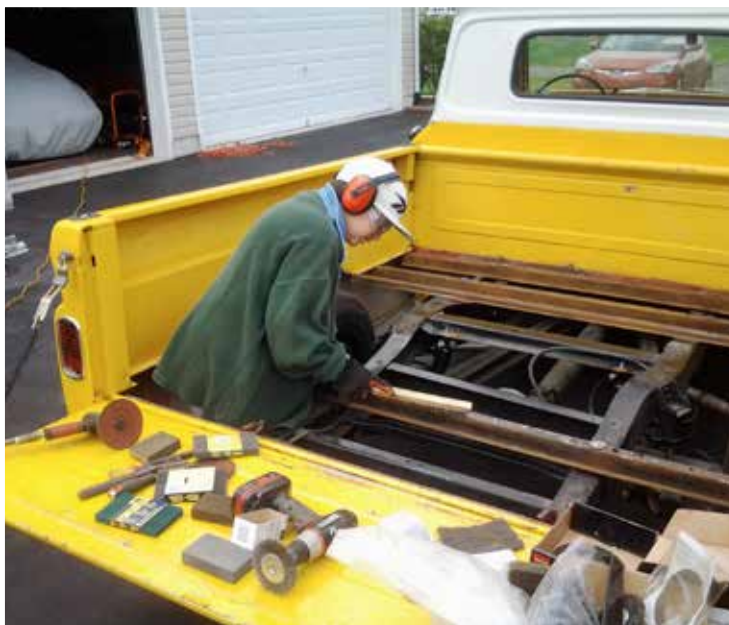
Reader's Rides

Jaden Newcomer's '65 Chevy C-10

As car show season comes to a close, it's time to reminisce about the weekends past and sharing our cars with many enthusiasts. At every show, old car buddies would gather, set up their folding chairs and talk about subjects that your parents told you to never discuss in public. You know, politics, the economy and the current state of the world. Our effort to address where our car hobby is going to be in the future has entered the conversation in recent years, especially in a day and age when our youth seem more interested in the internet and video games than getting their drivers license. The facts are, more and more of our youth today are not driving until after high school. Even fewer are interested in the automobile for anything other than a means of transportation.

Well not all. Meet 11-year old Jaden Newcomer from Ocean Pines, Maryland. Like other kids his age, he plays on a youth baseball team, he plays video games, but also loves the automobile. As a toddler he collected match box cars. He had hundreds of them. He would wipe them down and display them just like at a real car show. He knew all the makes and models. Just pick one up and he could tell you all about that brand of car.

Now Jaden has his own real project vehicle. It's a 1965 Chevy C10 Fleetside pickup truck. It is a joint project that Jaden shares with his grandfather. The truck was purchased on the internet from New Jersey and driven back to the eastern shore of Maryland. It broke down three times and Jaden's grandmother asked several times if this was money well spent.



Jaden is pleased to say that the truck is road-worthy, but still needs a lot of work. He works on it every chance he gets and can't wait for the day that he can take the truck to its first show or cruise-in. The truck has a 230 six cylinder with a three speed on the column. It was recently lowered using a kit from CPP and the rear wood bed is being replaced (see photos).

This summer, Jaden received an award from the Redman Club, for being the top youth judge at their car show in Georgetown, Delaware. Over 100 cars at the show and he picked five of the winners and the Best of Show. This recognition came as he competed against other youth judges. So there may be some hope for our hobby yet, if we continue to get more young men and women involved. Take a kid to a Car Show. Let's keep this part of history alive and shared for years to come.

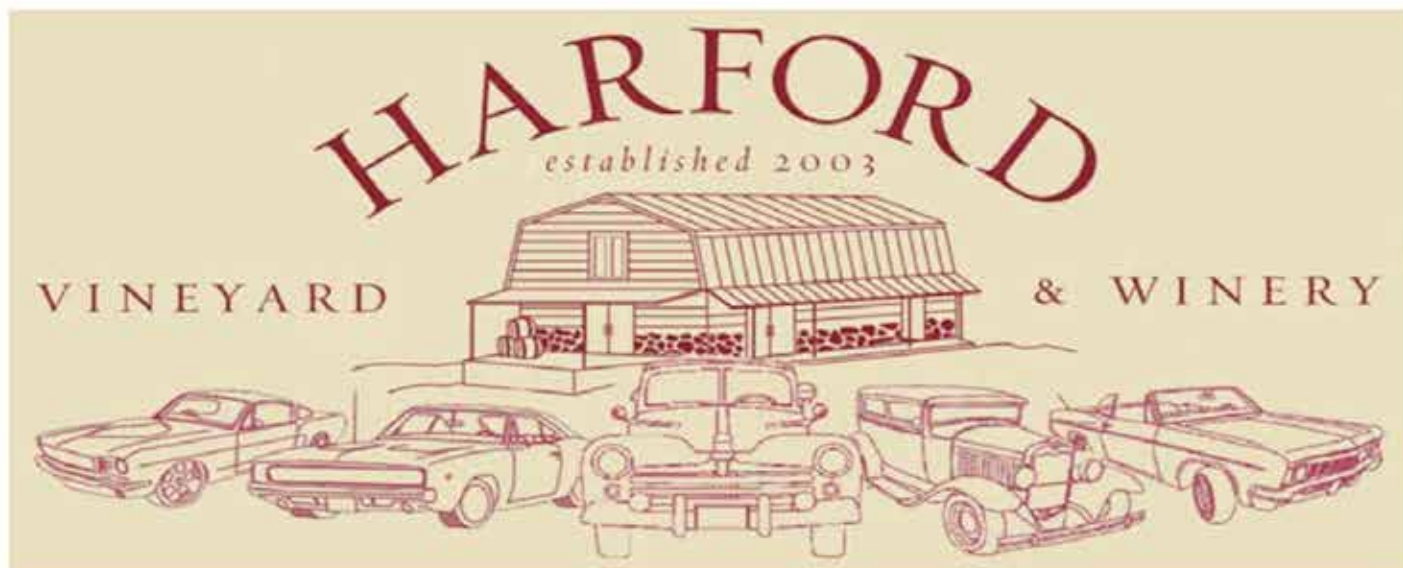

Carlisle Truck Nationals Host Trucks that Crush Cars – Trucks that Crush Records Too

For the THIRD YEAR in a Row – All New Showfield Record Set at the Carlisle Truck Nationals

The annual Carlisle Truck Nationals truck event is many things to many people. It's a place for truck clubs to converge and have fun. It's a place for owners of trucks of all sizes to get together and showcase their prized rides and custom creations. It's a place for families to enjoy an affordable day (or weekend) out seeing in real life the toys they play with at home. And, for the last three consecutive years, it's a place where Showfield growth has almost become expected, as yet ANOTHER Carlisle Truck Nationals (August 4-6, 2023) not only wowed guests through the gate, it SHATTERED another truck turnout record.

Though about 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 5, the previous record high was 2,594. That is, until big rig owner John Savoy registered his hauler, making the number 2,595. From there, every registrant set a new mark until the final number of 2,870 was reached by mid-day Sunday, August 6. That's right, a new mark by 276 trucks. Best of all, dating back to 2019 (and including the COVID year of 2020), truck show numbers have skyrocketed. For 2019, Carlisle hosted 1,703 registered trucks, in 2020 it was 1,570, 2021 saw a massive jump to 2,510, 2022 did 85 better with 2,595, and now 2,870 in 2023. Wow, what growth! Speaking of growth, the Big Rig Show and Shine stretched fence line to fence line; tallying some 231 rigs; up more than 150 over the past 10 years.

What brings the trucks, and guests back to Carlisle annually? How about the wide variety of showcase options. Guests can enjoy lowered mini trucks, lifted big trucks, monster trucks, antique big rigs, modern day haulers, antique fire trucks, cool custom vans, heavy equipment, and more. There's also a nice mix of family activities and fun for the kids too; including monster truck rides and shows, a kids cash grab, Kids bingo, all new in 2023, Mr. Mysterio the Magician, face painting, balloon animals, a goody bag, and best of all, FREE admission for all kids 12 and under. Kids had a chance to see in real life, the toys they play with at home and the payoff was well worth the cost of admission.

In addition, the Truck Nationals hosted a variety of automotive flea market vendors, business partners on the midway, and dozens of trucks for sale within the truck corral. Truck weekend celebrated 40 years of the Ranger too, and even put the wheels in motion with multiple competitions and pop-up parades. The low trucks skated around the grounds, while the 454 SS trucks showed off their style as well. In addition,



low truck limbo, high truck challenge, drop and drag, and the rolling burnout contest presented by Atturo Tires offered no shortage of truck themed activities for the throngs of showgoers. Club gatherings also help make it a fun weekend for attendees and participants.

Judged or non-Judged, the show was a smashing success and while 2023 is a wrap, the Carlisle Truck Nationals 2024 (August 2-4) is in the early planning. Registration for it is now open and planned 2024 display themes include a great gallery of antique fire trucks by way of the Old Fire Farts, Vanarama within the American Collectors Insurance Pavilion, American Truck Historical Society, the Big Rig Show and Shine, and more. Carlisle Events, celebrating 50 years in 2024, is a partner or producer of over a dozen annual collector car/truck events. 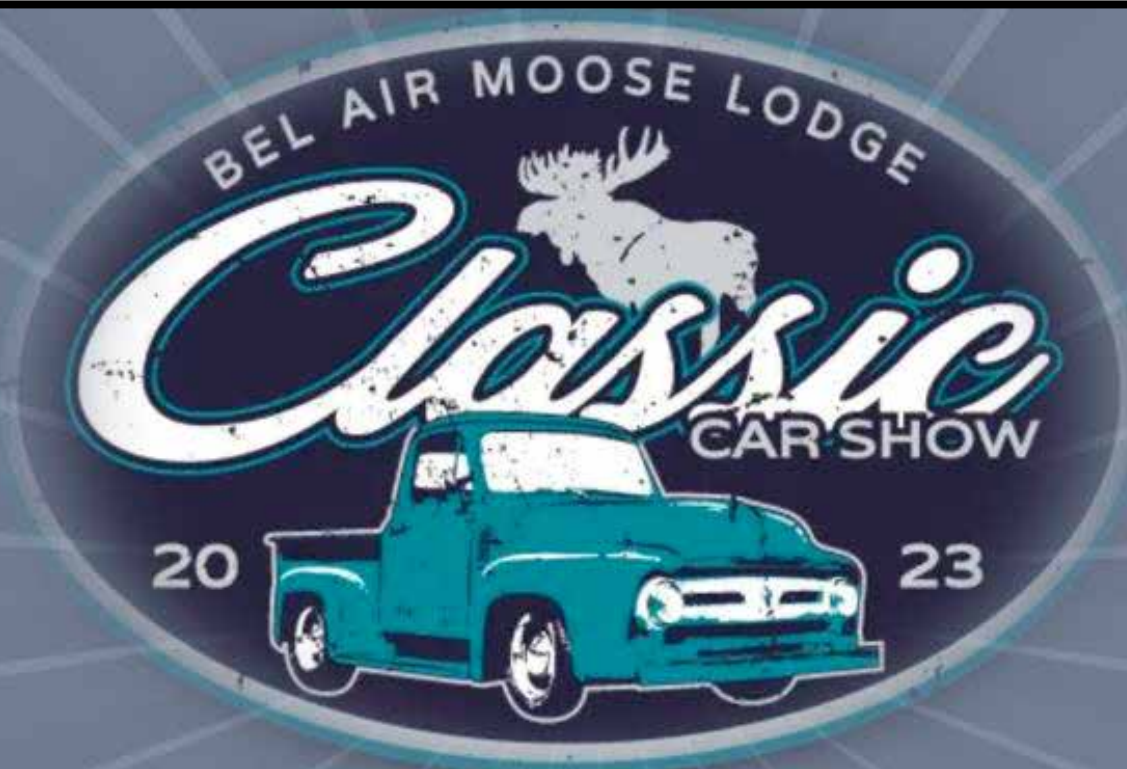

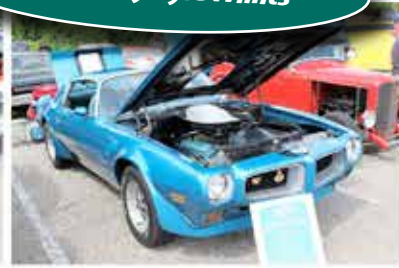
