### Jack Kosko's 1948 Mercury Eight Convertible

My Dad Jack Kosko bought this 1948 Mercury Eight Convertible at Moyer Motors in Baltimore on Dec 11 1947. He was 22 years old. Not to long out of the Navy and WWII.

Living in Baltimore and taking flying lessons locally he met my Mom



Rubye (at 18) through a blind date and my Mom was picked up in the Mercury on June 10 1948. They fell in love, even taking a trip to visit Mom's very large family in the mountains



of West Virginia in August of 1949. Mom being one of the oldest of 15 children. Driving the Mercury there with my Dad's Mother to meet her family. And on the way home the Mercury needed a Generator per my Mom's Diary.

Dad and Mom were married September 24, 1949. The Mercury was their Honeymoon car that took them to a little cabin south of Scranton PA where Dad was from.

Dad went on to start a successful construction company in Baltimore and they started a family. Having 2 boys and me in the 50s. A station wagon was needed. Dad started to collect a few other cars too. He enjoyed restoring histotic things. But! He sold the Mercury to a man who lived in Baltimore in the 60s. It sat in his yard and ended being towed to the police impound lot after a year or 2. The man lost his house to back taxes. Dad found out it was being sold at a tax sale and went and bought the Mercury back at that sale.

We moved in the late 1960s to a more rural area where he could have a larger garage. He sure did! But never letting the Mercury go again and keeping it in the garage. Going out after diner and on weekends. Any spare time he had he spent working on cars in the garage. My brother's helped when they could. Taking the Mercury apart, sanding, painting that Taffy

Tan color it came with. Mom going out to take pictures of Dad as he did the different steps of the restoration. That car is a true Family Car filled with the love of two people. Married 67 years! A true Love Story.

Dad spent most of the early 90s working on the Mercury. When he took the dash board off he found rice behind it from their wedding. New interior, new dash, new top and new paint. He had all the chrome done. New tires. He rebuilt the flathead. Just beautiful!!!

That was 1994 when he finished it. He drove it one time around the block, parked it in the garage, covered it up, and said. "I'm afraid someone will hit me"



and never drove it again. He really loved this car! Life went on and the Mercury sat covered up and became just a story to tell. My older brother tinkered with it over the years but no one got it drivable until I acquired it about 2 years ago. I had to have the motor rebuilt again, tires, some electrical and some other minor things. But it's pretty much the way Dad left it in 1994. I drive it and show it locally starting just this year. I don't go far and I understand how Dad felt but I can't just let it sit. That's not why I brought it home. I keep a tapestry on the back seat with 2 Angel's. That's my parents riding with me. It is a joy to drive!

Dad went full circle. Moving to buying and restoring WWII Avenger TBM Bombers just like he flew in in the war. He loved History and knew the importance of keeping it alive.

I acquired it and all the parts and pieces to the Mercury of which their are many and my Dad kept all paperwork. Even the original bill of sale. A true Legacy for me.

75 years I lost my Dad at 91 in May of 2017. I still had so many questions about the car until I lost Mom New Years Day 2022, also at 91.
