

Foundation Update by Doug Wood

Hello everyone! Let me first thank you for reading through the pages of this magazine and finding this editorial. Secondly, I'd like to welcome you to

Cruisin Ocean City, Maryland!

If you are new to this publication, it serves the general Mid-Atlantic region. It is chock full of photos from recent events, and if you look towards the back of the magazine, you'll see complete listings of upcoming car cruises, and shows all around the area. It has been a useful tool to cruisers for coming up on 15 years now!

I represent a nonprofit, called the *Custom and Classic Car Educational Foundation*. Once again, many of you readers may know about us, but I presume there is an enormous number of new readers that have no idea who and what we are. Let me tell you all a story that actually started 10 years ago.

Back in February 2014 at a gathering of clubs for breakfast, **Dave Bielecki**, the editor of this magazine, and I held an informal survey of rodders in the room. We determined that the average age of the folks in the room was **57**. It was at that point that Dave and I had confirmed what he and I had discussed many times before. There were simply too few young people getting involved in our hobby/ sport.

To that end, he and I, along with a couple of other volunteers started doing the legwork to establish this Foundation as a **501 C3 charitable organiza-tion** with the sole purpose of getting young people involved in the sport of hot rods and custom cars

and to offer them assistance with their education where it involves automobiles. Through car



cruises, shows, and other forms of fundraisers we have raised over **\$50,000** and have awarded just over **\$30,000** of that to deserving young people.

Our Training Scholarships

Early in our existence, we partnered with McPherson College out in Kansas. We would select an individual and send them to the mini session that McPherson holds in the spring. The individual would get to choose their discipline: engine building, bodywork, interiors, metal shaping, or choose from a couple of others. We would pay their airfare, tuition, and also pay for their room and board as well as meals. This allowed the student to find out in real time whether that was the appropriate choice for them. One of the individuals that won this grant actually went on to attend McPherson for four years and graduated with his degree! His name is Bill Bandy... Some of the folks selected for our educational assistance fund were not necessarily interested in college. They asked if they could go to a trade school or workshop / seminar.

Poppy's '60

My first ...and last... experience behind the wheel of Poppy's car came in 1978. Poppy asked me to get gas in the '60. When I returned, he asked if I hit a curb and I said yes. It was the last time I drove that car! I still, to this day, will not drive the '60.

Poppy bought his '60 Chevy Impala at Luby's Chevrolet on Monument Street in Baltimore. It is a 1960 Chevy Impala 2 door with a 283 V8 and power glide transmission in Cascade green with Jade green highlights. The car was built at the Broening Highway Assembly Plant in Baltimore. It spent most of it's life in my grandparent's garage, until 2016 when it was moved to our garage! So it really hasn't left the Baltimore area much in it's lifetime.



We are lucky enough to have retained the original title and bill of sale. My grandfather purchased the car when "the Point" (Bethlehem Steel) was on strike. It was his pride and joy. He didn't take it out much, but would start it, pull it out of the garage and then put it back. He did take it on several trips. It has been to Ocean City, Niagara Falls and Connecticut.

We know from the oil change stickers that half the miles, just around 5,000 were put on in the first 5 years. This was never his daily driver. The '60 currently has 11,500 original miles. The car was parked in the garage for almost 50 years until we recently started taking it to shows.

When we first got the car out of the garage, we only repaired items required to maintain safety and performance, but kept as much originality as possible. We had it towed to our friends shop, where all of the fluids were changed, a tune up and a bumper to bumper check was performed.



We replaced the tires with period correct tires from Coker Tires. At that point we decided we would keep the car exactly as Poppy had left it.

It wasn't until we were encouraged by several family members and friends that we decided we should share Poppy's car and the story of how we got here. I was very hesitant to bring Poppy's car out and I still am. Remember, I did hit the curb and was never allowed to drive it again! We are now glad to bring it out and share our story. I think this is what Poppy would want. Even though, we never envisioned being car show people, it has been a blast. We have met some of the nicest people. Folks don't mind sharing advice and teaching us how the car shows work. We have had help with everything from what class of car are we? To one of our friends working hard to get Poppy's original paint to shine, after 60 years of dirt! We have even had folks say they worked at Broening Highway at the time it was built and may have worked on it! The biggest plus though is we often show the car as a family. Everyone has a story about Poppy's'60.

We still have not changed the '60. His precious dog Princess still guards the backseat. He and grandmom's McDonald's cup holder is still ready to



hold their cokes and the trashcan is still available to keep things tidy. The '60 was even used as the Limo when my mom and stepdad were married. There is a piece of rice under the passenger seat and we will not remove it. The work we have performed on the car is as follows: the tires have been replaced except for the spare, we had the carburetor rebuilt, radiator recored and replaced the gas tank. And most recently, we had to replace the emergency brake cable and the brake lines.

The car has been in our family since Poppy drove it off the showroom floor. I am proud and lucky to be the current owner. Although I am always wondering if I will get struck by lightning if something would happen to Poppy's baby. We cherish the memories and consider it an honor to keep Poppy's '60 as he would want it. We will never sell it.


