



This is a big year for us here at the Custom and Classic Car Educational Foundation. On October 8 of 2014, we were officially incorporated by the State of Maryland and on April 7 of 2015 we were granted 501(c)(3) status by the federal government. Had you asked Dave and I back at the beginning, "would we still be here in 10 years"?...we may have shrugged our shoulders. But here we are 10 years later, and with the help of a wonderful and changing group of people we have collected over \$55,000 in donations of which over \$30,000 has been distributed to worthwhile individuals or groups. To date, we have sent six young people to McPherson College out in Kansas, one young person elected to go to Earlbeck Welding Technologies, and another chose to go to a Gene Winfield metal shaping workshop.

In addition to those deserving young folks, we have sponsored educational endeavors at Ron's Rod's in Kingsville, helped the Classic Motor Museum down in Saint Michaels Maryland to purchase a property which will be dedicated for the education of young folks and partnered with Motorama Productions to purchase a trailer for York Tech.

It has been our greatest pleasure to help make a difference in young folks lives when it comes to their desire to participate in our hobby, whether it's professionally or as a hobbyist. It is not lost on any of us here that these things could not have happened without generous donations from hot rodders and clubs in our area. We work very hard to be good stewards of your donations and it is our greatest hope that the **CCCEF** continues to grow and can make an impact on even more young folks careers and lives.

Please remember that we are an Mid-Atlantic based organization, and that any young person in our area may apply for our educational assistance fund. If you know anyone that fits that bill, please make sure you steer them to our website save the hobby.org in order that they can complete the application process and be considered for one of our awards.

We welcome any like-minded car enthusiasts to join us as a member. Help is always needed at one of our fundraisers. It is very rewarding to be able to say you did your part in finding younger people to ensure there is a future for this hobby. Just reach out to one of our members to join.

Here's to a bright future for the **CCCEF** and a wonderful working relationship with area clubs and hot rodders going forward!

St. Michael's Motor Museum



Getting Your Car Ready To Sell

It's spring and you've decided to sell your classic or muscle car. You've determined your price points and decided where you're going to present it for sale. It's now time to prepare the car for presentation and pictures. Remember, your camera is apt to show everything and

For most people, that preparation just includes washing, some vacuuming, and maybe waxing the car. Another option is to have the car detailed by a professional. Either approach can be acceptable, but ensure you've addressed the entire car, making it so appealing that if you were in the market, you would want to buy it.

is an indication of how well you cared for your car.

From the bottom up: The undercarriage is one of the most neglected and maintained or detailed areas. It's one that should be included in your sales presentation photos. So, at least wipe off the cobwebs, exposed tar, grease, mud and dirt on all suspension parts, floorboards, and wheel wells. You should also sand off any surface scale and rust on the chassis and exhaust system and consider painting some unsightly areas with a mat black spray.



Next, the engine compartment should be treated to the same type of preparation as the undercarriage. Clean the engine, inner fender panels. and at least wipe down the rest of the engine compartment. Ensure any insulation on the hood is trimmed and held firmly in

place. Preferably, straighten all wiring; polish any chrome or other brightwork.

In the trunk area, the mat and spare tire should be removed and thoroughly cleaned at the same time you clean the underside of the trunk lid and vacuum any loose dirt and scale from the trunk floor and inner fender wells. Ensure the trunk light works and all weather stripping is in place. If needed sand any surface scale and paint.

When doing the interior, floor mats should be removed and cleaned and all the carpeting and upholstery should be vacuumed and spot-cleaned. Remove all "hanging or personal items" such as dice, air freshener's or "Tchotchkes" (like ducks or dancing girls) from the dash. Clean and polish the dashboard; tighten any loose handles and cranks; and polish all chrome/stainless accents. Clean and ensure all gauges

are working. If you're anal, crawl under the dash and ensure that the wiring is neat, using wire ties if necessary. You should take a couple of pictures of this area for your presentation. Clean both sides of all windows.



Finally, the exterior should be washed and dried. Ensure that bugs and tar on the paint and chrome have been removed, even from those hard-to-reach places. Polish all chrome and other trim and ensure the windows are still clean and streak-free. If there are paint chips or loose trim pieces that need to be addressed, this is the time to do it. If necessary, use a cleaner wax on problem areas and wax the car. Finally, ensure that the wipers, headlights, turn signals, and taillights work as they should.

Going back to the bottom, wash and clean the tires, wheels, and hubcaps. For chrome or aluminum wheels, use the appropriate cleaning and polishing products. While you're at each wheel, ensure each tire has the proper tire pressure, both for safety and for the proper look in your pictures.

Look the entire car over to ensure it's ready for pictures. If you're satisfied – CONGRATULATIONS. Consider taking pictures in both good sunlight and in the dawn or dusk of a well-lit time to allow you to choose the best pictures for your presentation.

Present the best combination of pictures to impress and interest potential buyers. More isn't necessarily better. Pick your pictures according to the way they present the car in its entirety.

AACA Swap Meet at Howard County Fairgrounds


Thank you to everyone who came out to support our 50th annual Swap Meet. We were very thankful to have weather that was not rain or snow!
