Getting Your Car Ready To Sell

It's spring and you've decided to sell your classic or muscle car. You've determined your price points and decided where

you're going to present it for sale. It's now time to prepare the car for presentation and pictures. Remember, your camera is apt to show everything and is an indication of how well you cared for your car.

For most people, that preparation just includes washing, some vacuuming, and maybe waxing the car. Another option is to have the car detailed by a professional. Either approach can be acceptable, but ensure you've addressed the entire car, making it so appealing that if you were in the market, you would want to buy it.

From the bottom up: The undercarriage is one of the most neglected and maintained or detailed areas. It's one that should be included in your sales presentation photos. So, at least wipe off the cobwebs, exposed tar, grease, mud and dirt on all suspension

parts, floorboards, and wheel wells. You should also sand off any surface scale and rust on the chassis and exhaust system and consider painting some unsightly areas with a mat black spray.



Next, the engine compartment should be treated to the same type of preparation as the undercarriage. Clean the engine, inner fender panels, and at least wipe down the rest of the engine compartment. Ensure any insulation on the hood is trimmed and held firmly in

place. Preferably, straighten all wiring; polish any chrome or other brightwork.

In the trunk area, the mat and spare tire should be removed and thoroughly cleaned at the same time you clean the underside of the trunk lid and vacuum any loose dirt and scale from the trunk floor and inner fender wells. Ensure the trunk light works and all weather stripping is in place. If needed sand any surface scale and paint.

When doing the interior, floor mats should be removed and cleaned and all the carpeting and upholstery should be vacuumed and spot-cleaned. Remove all "hanging or personal items" such as dice, air freshener's or "Tchotchkes" (like ducks or dancing girls) from the dash. Clean and polish the dashboard; tighten any loose handles and cranks; and polish all chrome/ stainless accents. Clean and ensure all gauges

are working. If you're anal, crawl under the dash and ensure that the wiring is neat, using wire ties if necessary. You should take a couple of pictures of this area for your presentation. Clean both sides of all windows.



Finally, the exterior should be washed and dried. Ensure that bugs and tar on the paint and chrome have been removed, even from those hard-to-reach places. Polish all chrome and other trim and ensure the windows are still clean and streak-free. If there are paint chips or loose trim pieces that need to be addressed, this is the time to do it. If necessary, use a cleaner wax on problem areas and wax the car. Finally, ensure that the wipers, headlights, turn signals, and taillights work as they should.

Going back to the bottom, wash and clean the tires, wheels, and hubcaps. For chrome or aluminum wheels, use the appropriate cleaning and polishing products. While you're at each wheel, ensure each tire has the proper tire pressure, both for safety and for the proper look in your pictures.

Look the entire car over to ensure it's ready for pictures. If you're satisfied – CONGRATULATIONS. Consider taking pictures in both good sunlight and in the dawn or dusk of a well-lit time to allow you to choose the best pictures for your presentation.

Present the best combination of pictures to impress and interest potential buyers. More isn't necessarily better. Pick your pictures according to the way they present the car in its entirety.





1941 Ford Deluxe Woody Wagon Discovered on U.S.S. Yorktown

NOAA oceanographers recently sent remotely operated submersibles down to the wreckage of **The USS Yorktown**, discovered in Hawaii back in 1998, to take a closer look and discovered something that no one would have expected to see. **The USS Yorktown** is one of the more famous ships in U.S. naval history, (though there have been more than one bearing that name). Yorktown was sunk by the Japenese during the **Battle of Midway** after crippling two Japanese fleet carriers and saving two other American ships from aerial counterattacks. 
