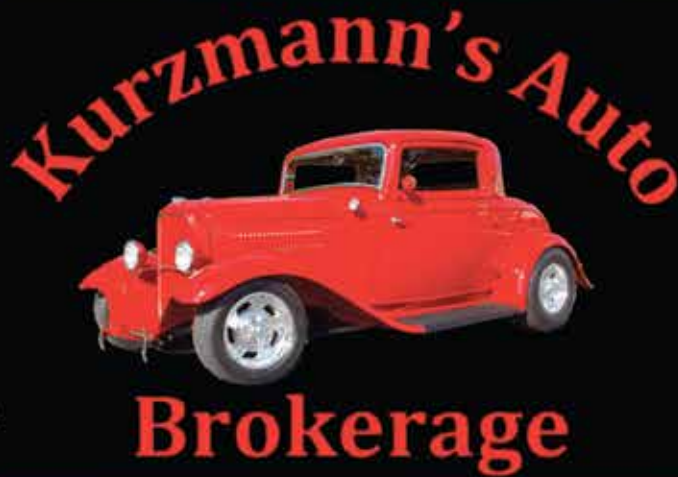

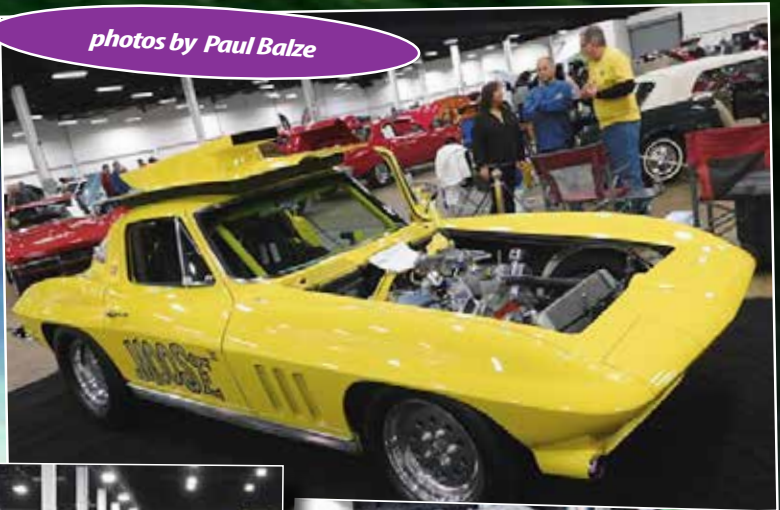

Good Pictures Make a Difference

Let's discuss taking pictures of your car. More specifically, taking pictures of your car when listing it for sale. I do not profess to be a photojournalist or professional photographer, but after almost 12 years of selling vehicles on the internet of which 85% sell without the buyer coming to see them, here are some ideas you can use when selling your vintage, classic, or current auto.

First and foremost, take pictures outside on a sunny day and in the sunshine. Do not try and do it in a garage, at night under lights, or under a shady tree. People need to see the "real" color and finish of your car.

Next, make sure the entire subject is in the photo, i.e. the entire car or just the engine compartment. For the outside of your car, take $\frac{3}{4}$ shots from off the end and back of each fender. Make sure the windows are in the 'up' position to show the condition of the glass. Be sure to include the roof, so use a ladder.

For interior shots, include the entire seat and not just the horizontal and vertical panel of the seat. Open the door and take one shot which includes the door panel, dashboard, and seats. Take a close up of the odometer. Photograph the **UNDERSIDE OF THE DASHBOARD** on both sides. You need to show the wiring. If it looks like a bowl of spaghetti and you don't have time to address it, show it. Don't try and hide anything. Roll down both the driver's and passenger windows and open the door to get a complete shot of the seats and door jams. Don't forget the headliner, back seat, and be sure the dome light works.

For the trunk area, take everything out and pull up the mat to show the flooring. If you need to, remove the spare tire. Be sure to photograph the back panel where the taillights are connected.



In the engine compartment use the ladder to shoot down on the engine and fender panels. If you have a GM vehicle, be sure to take a shot of the Trim Tag on the firewall. Show the top of the suspension and master cylinder. If you have a custom radiator, shoot it. Remove the air cleaner and show the carburetor or fuel injection system.

Now let's move to the undercarriage. If you have a lift or set of ramps, use them. Start at the front of the car and show the type of steering the car has, such as rack & pinion. Show the brake system and bottom side of the engine. Moving to the mid-section of the car, show the bottoms of the rocker panels, possibly the transmission, and the floorboards. If you added frame connectors be sure to photograph them. Take a shot which includes the differential and gas tank. Then one showing just the rear suspension.

Finally, and these are the more difficult shots, show any blemishes such as scratches or cracks in the paint. Any rust bubbles which are starting to come through. All cracked or foggy windows or pitted chrome. Do not be afraid to show that the car was driven. No matter what anyone says, "There is no perfect car." I have yet to see it.

Hopefully these points are not too difficult to understand. They are easy to shoot and help answer questions potential buyers often ask.

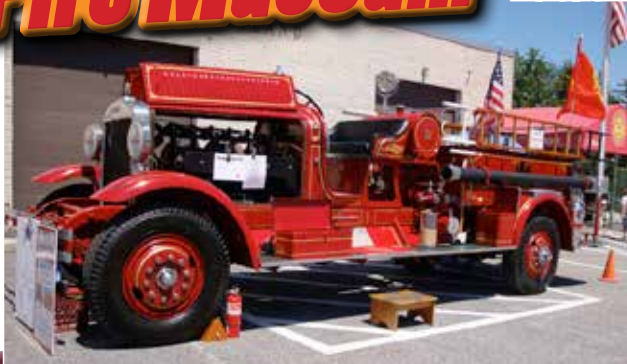

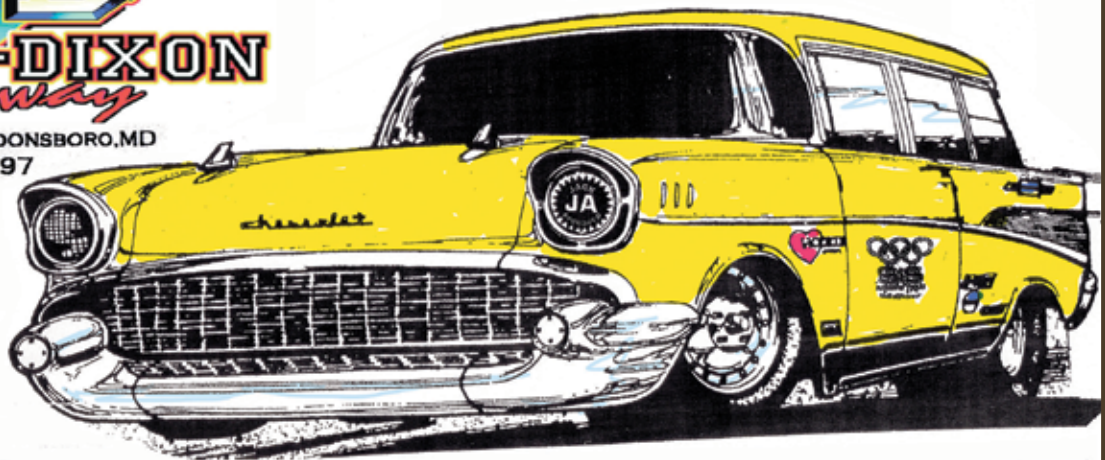

Car Show Update

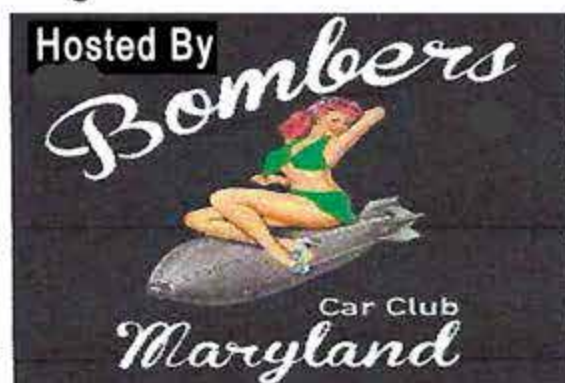

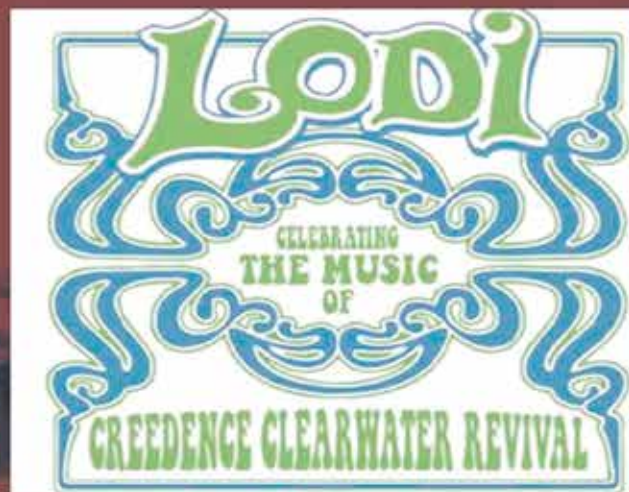

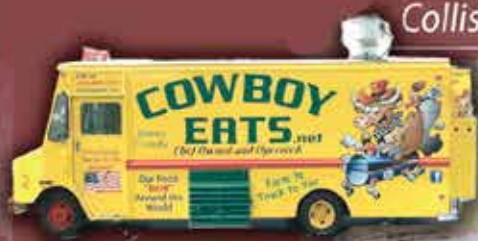

T.W. Scott's 1951 Ford Crestliner

Remembering An Old Friend – '51 Crestliner Lives to Drive Again!

Several years ago, a longtime friend (Richard "Dick" Fisher) who loved all kinds of antique and classic automobiles suddenly passed away leaving many of his dreams and hopes unfinished. We had worked and toured together over the years maintaining and improving the antique automobiles he and his wife drove; often we would survey the garage and reminisce about "what could be" on the other projects that he dreamed of someday bringing back to their glory.

One of the beauties from his collection was a 1951 Ford Crestliner. A "Flathead" V8 engine with a 3-speed manual transmission and a column mounted shifter. The 239 cubic inch Flathead engine was estimated to produce 100 horsepower. The special trim features for the Crestliner were two-tone side trim (Hawaiian Bronze with a dark brown insert), special hubcaps, brown vinyl top, and upscale interior trim. Even with these features in 1951 Ford sold about 103,000 Custom Victorias and 8,703 Crestliners.

This Crestliner had been sitting for over 15 years with layers of dust in a dry garage in Willow Street PA. Early steps included removal of spark plugs and marvel mystery oil soaked in the cylinders; then a fresh 6V positive ground battery and multiple engine turns to move oil and build pressure. The fuel delivery and carburetor required much attention as well as many of the under hood wiring had to be replaced because of age. When the "wake up" (start) process began, a 50:1 fuel mix (used for 2-cycle engines) was pulled from separate tank source and the ol' crestliner came alive! I have worked on many antique autos over the years and I am filled with excitement each and every time an old engine breathes its life again following years of dormant sleeping. But wait, now the desire to drive it was greater than before, however the brake gremlins had snuck into the master/wheel cylinders as well as the rubber and metal brake lines. Ironically, parts were available in the market (online) and the crestliner was up for her debut drive (and stops!) at the Jarrettsville Lion's Club annual "Romancing the Chrome" show April 2025. The drive and sound of the ol' flat head

motor was worth the wait.

Many fond friend memories were re-kindled as hours and days past while the Crestliner was cleaned, polished and mechanically corrected. Friends stopped by the farm and helped with encouragement and thoughts/comments/supplier sources during the awaking steps and for that I extend my sincere appreciation and thankfulness for those who share in the love of saving the old classic and antique automobiles.

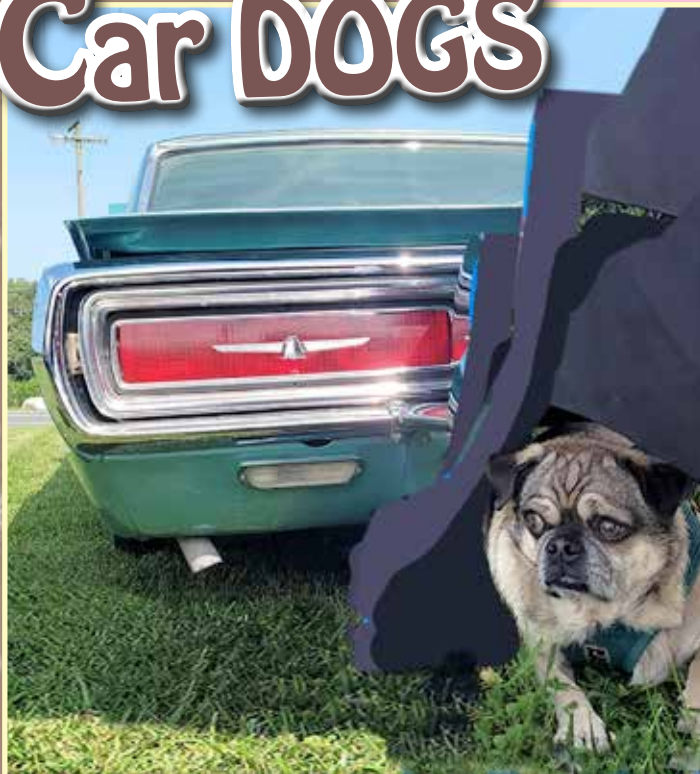
